Arizona Daily Star Did Not List Bill's 1st Quarter Report

On Sunday, April 28, 2024, the Arizona Daily Star's Political Reporter Charles Borla under the headline "Big Money Flowing into Campaigns", published a story online and in Sunday's print edition on page B1. Which reported on the information in the required first quarter financial reports for all the candidates, that qualified for the various primary elections, that is all but one. This was 100% erroneous, the campaign on Monday morning emailed Gannett Media Legal to challenge the miss reporting. Within two hours the online story was corrected and the promise to publish a correction in Tuesday's paper was made. The Star kept its word and on page A2 the correction can be found.
